

- You must obtain the casualty's **consent** prior to giving assistance, provided they are conscious.
- Your **duty of care** as a first aider is to provide a standard of care appropriate to your training, and to not go beyond your own skills or limitations.
- It is important to consider a casualty's age, gender and cultural background before approaching them for care. It is also important to **respect** their privacy after care has been provided.
- Using a barrier (e.g. gloves or masks) helps to minimise the risk of cross-infection.
- You should prioritise casualties with the worse injuries when you can.
- Should a bystander arrive while you are aiding a casualty, immediately ask them to call 000.
- Some risks when providing assistance include: back injuries, sharp objects or aggressive behaviour.
- Providing first aid in a workplace must adhere to procedures, guidelines and regulations provided by the Workplace, ARC (Australian Resuscitation Council) or the State Government.
- The First Aid Code of Practice cover workplace regulations and procedures, such as: the training requirements for first aiders, how to identify, assess and manage hazards, and the contents of first aid kits in the workplace.
- To stay up to date, you should attend refresher course and be aware of legislation, policy and procedure changes and ANZCOR guidelines.






